



Know all vocab we have learned and discussed in class. Sometimes there is a word bank, sometimes there is not! Sometimes you have to write a definition, sometimes you do not. (Hint, hint!)

A type of ruler that helps you measure distance on a map

The directions halfway between cardinal directions; northeast, southeast, southwest, northwest

A measure of distance

A table or list that explains symbols appearing on a map

Distance, measured in degrees, north or south of the Equator. These lines run east to west on the grid.

A symbol or set of arrows on a map that show north, south, east, and west.

Distance, measured in degrees, east or west of the Prime Meridian. These lines run north and south on the grid.

One of the four main directions on a compass; north, south, east, and west

The intersection pattern formed by lines of latitude and longitude

The line of longitude drawn from the North Pole to the South Pole

The line of latitude drawn at the halfway point between the North and South Pole

Half of the Earth divided by either the Equator (northern, southern) or Prime Meridian (eastern, western)
